Nick Begakis, Chair of ACMA, welcomed everyone and opened the information session.

Nick - Food Business Incubator information

Nick introduced and welcomed Peter from Beyond Bank to talk about their entrepreneur program.

Peter - Beyond Bank

Beyond Bank is a lot more than just banking with the business also focussing on community & development. Beyond bank is a customer owned business which is focused on reinvesting in local communities to make a difference and make the community stronger. Beyond bank value what entrepreneurs give to the community, new jobs, new pathways to employment and how they take advantage of their passion to provide those opportunities. Beyond bank is offering new entrepreneur program which includes business grants (with grants up to \$20k), and mentoring to connect entrepreneurs to the appropriate networks; provide direction for the right people to contact and anything to do to support your ideas.

Nick introduced and welcomed Dorothy from Health Connexions to talk about their opportunities within Glenside.

Dorothy - Health Connexions

Dorothy from Health Connexions is working with the Glenside Precinct to develop a long term café space for the precinct. This space includes an outdoor area and is flexible for opening such as 9am-5pm, 7 days or 5 days a week. At this stage there are no café's within the area, which hold 500 employees and 200 visitors weekly with a residential component to be built in the area. There is the opportunity to look at a partnership with Glenside such as employing employees with mental illness as a pathway back into the community. This is a negotiable model and Dorothy encouraged any interested entrepreneurs to get in contact for possible ideas for the space.



Nick introduced and welcomed Ryan to talk about his current work with the Market.

Ryan Kris – Yourpantry.com.au

Ryan Kris is an entrepreneur that has launched Yourpantry.com.au which is an online platform for traders within the Market. This model has been built with ACM, highlighting the great food, products, accessibility to the customer and allow us to work together to achieve a great outcome.

Nick introduced and welcomed Sasha to touch on working with service and youth council.

Sasha – Service and Youth Council

Exploring and utilising someone like Ryan allows us to provide and deliver to businesses. This also allows the opportunity for young people to go through training (such as food handling procedures) to pick up the orders and deliver in the CBD to customers.
